Classroom Guidelines

1. **Come prepared to learn.** Always have your supplies with you. Supply list:
 - 1 1/2 - 2inch binder
 - 5 dividers
 - Loose leaf paper
 - Pens/pencils
 - Grading pen
 - Textbook
2. **Allow others to learn.** Treat other students and teacher with respect!! Manners are very important in this room. Keep cell phones silent and out of sight (no texting) or phones will be taken away.
3. **Be on time.** You must be in your seat when the bell rings. Detentions will result.
4. **Care for our classroom supplies.** Put supplies neatly away and close cabinets.
5. **Be safe.** Follow all classroom safety rules taught in class. Sign out when you have permission to leave the room.
6. **Practice maturity.** Act appropriately around the preschoolers. Keep unnecessary conversations out of the classroom. Wear "kid friendly" clothing on Apple Tree Days. You will be on the floor with children! Dress appropriately when teaching as well!
7. **Know your boundaries.** Use all cabinets designated for child development only.
8. **Succeed!** Homework, organized binders, and projects are due on the due date. Be responsible to get work turned in! If unexcused absence on the due date for a project, turn it in the next day, but will be late and the grade will be lowered one letter grade from what is earned.
9. **Make up work.** One day given for each day absent. See me and/or assignment folder for missed work!
10. **Show up!** It's necessary to be present on your teaching dates. Pick up the Real Care Baby in room 301 after school on your scheduled date. Failure to do so will result in a zero for the project! Rescheduling is unacceptable. Signed contract must be turned in before scheduling!
11. **Stay put.** Please stay at your table until the bell dismisses you.
